For ESOL courses you will be assessed in the following areas:

- Speaking and listening (with a tutor)
- Reading and writing

For all other qualification courses, you will be assessed in a mixture of ways:

- BKSB online assessment
- Written task
- Face to face interview

Launched in October this year across the UK, Multiply is a new government-funded programme to help adults improve their numeracy skills.

If you're aged 19 and over and don't have maths GCSE at grade C or 4 or functional skills level 2, you can access free numeracy courses through Multiply, at City College Peterborough, to build your confidence with numbers and gain a qualification.

Good numeracy skills may unlock new job opportunities and lead to higher wages or prepare you for further study. They also help in everyday life, such as helping children with homework and budgeting money.

You can enrol on courses from beginners to more advanced courses such as GCSE Maths, Functional Skills Qualifications, or equivalent. You may need to take an initial assessment to find your current level, to join a course.

THE NEXT LEVEL QUALIFICATION

T Levels are new qualifications for school leavers, 16–19-year-olds, focusing on career roles and backed by the Government and British business.

T Levels are a 2-year qualification, an alternative level 3 option to A Levels and Apprenticeships. They offer the young person the option of a hybrid learning package of college study and real-life work placement experience. Each T Level includes a 45-day / 315 hours^{*} of work placement.

Upon successful completion the young person will achieve UCAS points (a T Level is the equivalent to 3 A Levels) enabling them to apply for university, apply for a higher apprenticeship or use the skills and behaviours gained to step into their future career.

City College Peterborough will be offering T Levels in Education and Childcare, Catering and Management and Administration from September 2023.

T Levels





At City College Peterborough we will be offering the following T Levels:

- Education and Childcare T Level, assisting teaching occupational specialism
- Management and Administration T Level, business support occupational specialism
- Catering T Level, professional cookery occupational specialism



A T Level is comprised of:

• Technical qualification – classroom-based element where students will learn about their chosen industry and specific competencies aimed at their occupational specialism.

- Industry placement for a minimum of 315 hours where students will work with local businesses to gain the skills and behaviours necessary to have a meaningful career in their chosen field.
- English, maths and digital skills forming the basis of the transferable skills that are sought after by employers.

How is a T Level assessed?

The technical qualification is assessed through written exam and an employer set project. The occupational specialism through synoptic assessments.

As well as these assessments you will also need to complete the industry placement.

Entry requirements:

Students will need a minimum of 5 GCSEs at grade 5 or above including English and maths. Those students wanting to do a Health T Level will need Science at grade 5 or above also.

A previous qualification in the subject area is also desirable but not necessary.

Payment of your chosen course(s) is as follows:

- 1. INDIVIDUAL COURSE FEE UP TO £150 (after concession)
- Full payment must be made at the time of enrolment.

- Full payment at the time of enrolment (mandatory for a one-term course). Or for a two-term course:
- 50% of course fee at the time of enrolment.
- 50% by 1 March 2023

- Full payment must be made at the time of enrolment (mandatory for a one-term course)
- Or for a two-term course:
- 50% of course fee at the time of enrolment.
- 50 % by 1 March 2023

The service reserves the right to request full payment at the time of enrolments. N.B. If you are enrolling on more than one course at the same time (except Saturday courses), the collective cost of all courses, after concessions, will determine if instalments are payable.

Please note that you are liable for the full course fee regardless of when you leave the course and irrespective of your payment method. It is important that you make the payment(s) by the date(s) stated to secure your place on the course and for you and fellow students to benefit from this facility. If you have difficulty paying larger amounts in one payment, please contact our Customer Service team on (01733) 761361 or in person at City College Peterborough in Brook Street. For some courses that result in a qualification there may be an exam entry fee to pay. **Please check at the time of enrolment**.

On some practical courses, there may be a small charge for materials. You will be advised of this at enrolment.

Concessionary Fees

A fee reduction may apply for learners who are:

- 1. Over 60 years of age and unwaged (non- qualification courses only)
- 2. Receiving Jobseeker's allowance (including the partner where the claim is joint)
- 3. Receiving Employment Support Allowance (ESA) in the Work-Related Activity Group
- 4. Receiving Universal Credit (unemployed) and mandated (required) to undertake skills training
- 5. Receiving Pension Tax Credit (non- qualification courses only)
- 6. Aged 19-23 and do not currently hold a Level 2 and studying for a qualification funded by the Education Skills Funding Agency.

Refund Policy

Refunds will only be given on the following grounds:

- 1. The course is cancelled by the Service
- 2. The learner cancels their place not less than 14 days (about 2 weeks) before the start date. The Policy does not apply to short courses of fewer than 2 sessions e.g. Saturday courses, where no refund will be given.
- 3. The learner withdraws from a course due to illness and can produce a doctor's certificate
